

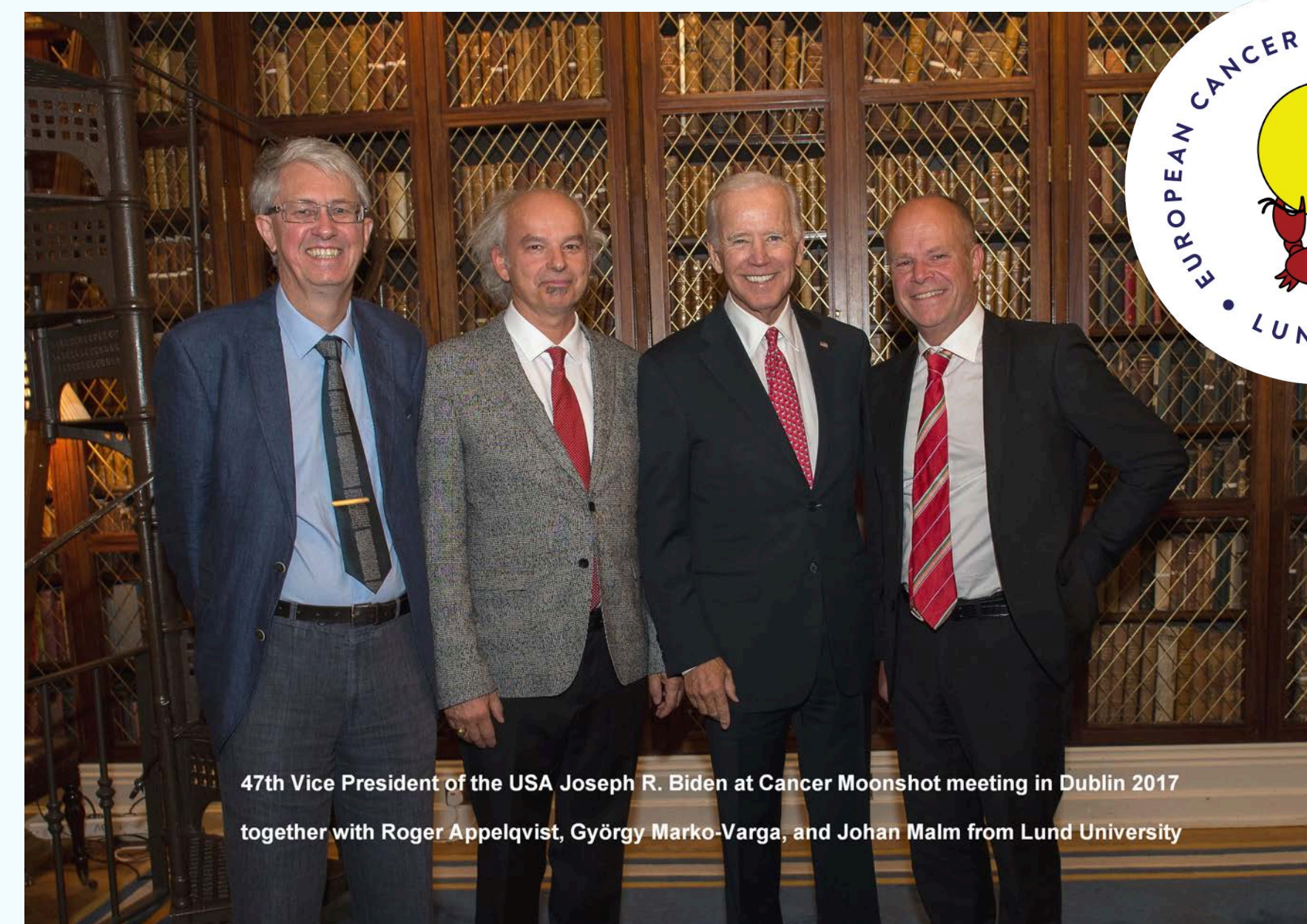
Our Mission

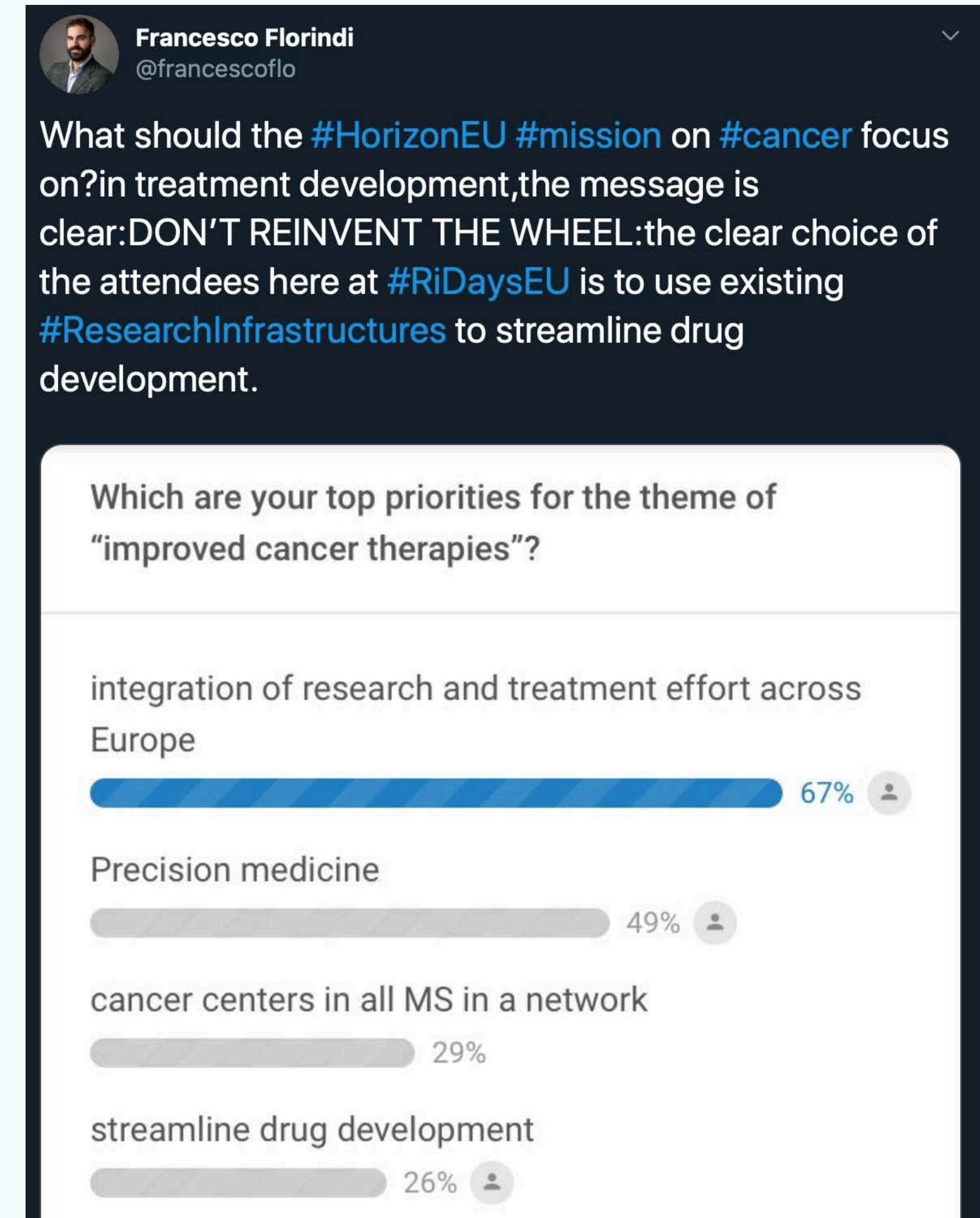
