Some roles of language and the corresponding audiences


- Carrier of cultural content: *cultural heritage*
- Record of the past: *archaeology, history*
- Main communication instrument within and across societies: *sociology, anthropology*
- Preserving and disseminating our knowledge: *all disciplines*
- Instrument to formulate rules for society: *law, theology*
- Carrier of information: *media studies, journalism*
- Means of human expression: *literary studies, art, psychology*
- Focus of cognitive processes: *brain studies, psychology, neurology*
- Component of national or cultural identity: *political sciences, social sciences*
- Object of study: *linguistics*, *language learning*
- Object of computer processing: *language and speech technology*

Parliamentary records

- great potential for reuse and re-purposing within many fields of study SSH and beyond:
 - is suited for both *close reading* and *distance reading*
 - *Humanities*: history, language change, discourse analysis ...
 - Social sciences: social and cultural dynamics, political sciences, economics ...
- considered a rich data type
 - apart from linguistic content, rich in metadata (speaker, party affiliation, age, sex, education, origin, duration of speech)
 - apart from linguistic content, rich in extralinguistic clues (interruptions, voting results)
- but also
 - often presenting itself as messy or noisy data
 - calling for links with data in other modalities than text and speech
 - created under specific circumstances that need to be well understood before strong conclusions can be drawn

ParlaMint

- Motivation: Parliamentary data directly reflects the most recent events with a global impact on human health, social life and economics such as the current COVID-19 pandemic.
- Goal: Provide policy making resources and tools for focused observations on trends, opinions, decisions on *lockdowns* and restrictive measures as well as on the consequences with respect to: health, medical care systems, employment, etc. during pandemic times.
- Scope: Coverage: 16 languages, 20+ million words each

ParlaMint workflow

ParlaMint

- Getting the parliamentary data and metadata
- 2. Converting them into the Parla-CLARIN schema
- 3. Validation (formal and qualitative)
- 4. Linguistic annotation with syntactic structures of Universal Dependencies and Named Entities
- 5. Making the corpora available through concordancers and Parlameter
- 6. On-going: Adding more parliaments
- On-going: Building use cases in Political Science and Digital Humanities based on the corpus data

Male vs. Female Key Lemmas






